## Conditions

1. Liability for breach of this Home Insulation Installation Warranty shall:
  - (a) not include damage caused by anyone other than the Installer or its authorised sub-contractor or by any agent of either of them, or by any other contractor beyond the Installer's control including the pre-existing state of repair of the Property, fire, lightning, salt air, chemicals, industrial fall-out, fumes, liquids, solids, animals or rain;
  - (b) not include any consequential loss;
  - (c) (except in the case of rectification of any immediate physical damage caused directly to the Property by the Installer in the course of installing the Batts) be limited to the rectification or (at the Installer's option) paying for the cost of rectification.
2. This Home Insulation Installation Warranty is the only express warranty or condition given by the Installer with respect to the installation of the Batts. No other guarantee warranty or condition is given, express or implied, other than a warranty or condition implied under state, territory or federal legislation which may not be excluded, restricted or modified by that legislation.
3. Liability for breach of any condition or warranty imposed under the *Trade Practices Act* (other than under section 69) relating to services which are not of a kind ordinarily acquired for personal, domestic or household use or consumption, will, at the Installer's option, be limited to installing Batts again or payment for the cost of installing Batts again.
4. A claim under this Home Insulation Installation Warranty must be submitted in writing to the Installer **within 30 days of the date of this Warranty**, enclosing this Warranty together with written proof of the date of installation in the form of an invoice or receipt from the Installer or its authorised sub-contractor.
